# **SUMMARY**

Under the general supervision of the Service Manager, the Propane Service Technician installs and services equipment systems for commercial and residential customers.

# **PRIMARY FUNCTIONS**

The Propane Service Technician is primarily responsible for the following functions:

- Installs propane equipment and sets tanks for new customers.
- Performs service calls and preventative maintenance on existing systems.
- Completes system inspections, repairs, and tests.
- Responds to emergency calls as needed.
- Provides mentorship to Apprentice.
- May perform propane deliveries as necessary.
- Performs all other similar duties as required.
